RECOVERY PROGRAMMING:

Support allows us to offer mutual aid groups by engaging individuals socially, with a recovery focus, in activities that strengthen the 4 pillars of recovery: home, health, community, purpose.

PREVENTION PROGRAMMING: Support allows us to provide individualized prevention services and education that engage health, social, educational, and behavioral impacts of substance use. The goal is to develop a supportive community that enables children, adolescents, young adults, and families to have a healthy environment to thrive and grow.

FAMILY SUPPORT NAVIGATION:

Funding for this program allows us to provide help the loved ones of those struggling with substance use disorders. Our goal is to help the whole family find recovery through a holistic approach, one that incorporates the strengths of all treatment and recovery agencies in our community.

HOW TO GIVE:

TIM FOLEY RECOVERY CLASSIC: Applied Underwriters Invitational Thursday, September 25, 2025

The Annual Tim Foley Recovery Classic Golf Tournament will partner with the Applied Underwriters Invitational in 2025, the top charity golf event in the country. The event will be held at Shenendoah Golf Course at the Turning Stone Casino. The Invitational aims to support communities and assist those in need, benefiting over 75 charities and raising over \$287 million since its start.
