#### Pregnant/ Expecting Families examples of Push Notifications

- Cloth or disposable diapers? Who will be my baby's health care provider? Where will my baby sleep? Discover new resources in your community for new parents and their babies.
- Expecting parents, it is never too early to begin building a strong and trusting relationship with your baby!
- Even before your baby is born, they want to hear your voice. When you sing and talk to them, you are building your relationship with them and supporting their future language skills.
- Take a look in the mirror. That person you are looking at is your baby's most important teacher.
- Start to make your home a safe place for your baby to explore. Lie, then crawl on the floor. Your baby is going to be spending lots of time there you too. Why not start going through a safety checklist to keep your little explorer safe and sound?



#### **Communicating With Your Child**

Even before your baby is born he wants to hear your voice. When you sing and talk to him, you are building your relationship with him and supporting his future language skills.





#### Parents of Infant examples of Push Notifications

All parents, especially first-time parent experience a wide variety of feelings—this is normal. Never be afraid to ask for help if you need it.

- The American Academy of Pediatrics recommends putting your baby to sleep alone, on their back, in a safe crib with a firm mattress without pillows, blankets or toys.
- Locate childcare programs near you by using the NYS Childcare, Afterschool and Home Visiting porgram locator in the Parent Portal!
- Always use rear facing infant car seats that are properly installed. Even on the shortest trip and even when they protest being buckled in.
- If you have questions about your child's development, check with your child's health care provider or call the NYS Growing Up Healthy Hotline (1-800-522-5006) to find a local Early Intervention Program.






#### Parents of 4-year-old examples of Push Notifications

A week or two before school begins, have your children go to bed at a set bedtime and get up at a set wake up time to help prepare for school.

- Is your child dealing with shyness in school? Help your child grow their confidence and remind them of a time when they were in a new situation and got through it.
- Are you looking for ways to have a productive parent/teacher conference? This resource may be able to help!
- Eye exams for young children are extremely important because children are often more responsive to treatment when problems are diagnosed early.
- Does your child have asthma? Learn your school's asthma policies and asthma emergency procedures. At the beginning of each school year, talk to your school nurse and teacher about your child's asthma.


